- Reg. No. 13.7: Finding Date 01/11/2017. Regulation 13.7: Staff and children shall all wash their hands with soap under warm, running water: * before they eat or prepare food * after they use the toilet * after handling animals * after playing outside.
- Reg. No. 13.1: Finding Date 01/11/2017. Regulation 13.1: Staff shall use universal precautions when in contact with all blood and other body fluids that are potentially infectious (saliva, nose and eye discharges, vomit, urine, feces) by following the procedures listed below: * wear non-porous latex or vinyl gloves unless the fluid can be easily contained by the material used to clean it up (tissue for noses, etc.) being careful not to get any of the fluid being handled into eyes, nose, mouth or open sores/cuts * clean and then disinfect any surfaces coming into contact with body fluids using a bleach dilution according to manufacturer's instructions for disinfecting * dispose of contaminated materials and store launderable items in securely sealed containers or bags * wash hands with soap and water.
