Do you...

- ➔ Want to get a college degree?
- ➔ Need financial help while you're going to college?
- ➔ Have a minor child at home?
- ➔ Have little or no income?
- ➔ Live in Vermont?

If you answered YES to these questions, this program may be able to help!

PSE helps eligible parents to earn two- or four-year undergraduate college degrees so they can get good paying jobs and support their families.





Who is Eligible

Parents:

- ➔ With minor, dependent children at home
- ➔ Who live in Vermont
- ➔ With incomes under 150% of the federal poverty level

The Benefits Available

- ➔ Monthly cash payments
- ➔ Support services
- ➔ Help with childcare, transportation and school supplies

Your Responsibilities

You must:

- ➔ Be accepted into college
- ➔ Secure the funds to cover tuition (e.g., grants, loans and scholarships)
- ➔ Agree to work no more than 20 hours a week
