What I love: The Wonder Pets - Looking at myself in the mirror - bubbles - balls - looking at books - numbers - letters - going outside to play - swinging - getting tickled- wind in my face - big movement

My strengths are: I'm very affectionate - I have a good sense of humor - I know my numbers and some colors, shapes, and letters - I have good visual learning skills - I like to observe my environment, (I am very cautious in new situations)

This year I have learned: How to walk, run, and to go up and down stairs - How to eat with a spoon and drink from a cup - I am beginning to understand if I ask for something I'll get it - I have learned to follow one step directions, ex. "Go to truck" - I have learned how to dance and follow interactive songs like (Ring around the Rosie and Itsy Bitsy Spider)

It is difficult for me to: Communicate my needs verbally - to participate in play activities, ex. I need one block at a time when I build or else I won't necessarily build with blocks, I will just scatter blocks instead, and this is true for most toys that have several pieces - I have been practicing turn taking, though it is still quite difficult for me to take turns - If I become frustrated, I may need to be redirected (The Wonder Pets and bubbles help with this)

What helps me learn: Picture schedules - verbal visual prompts - when transitioning from one activity to another, say "bye bye" to previous activity - verbal mand training, ex. Hold ball close to mouth, say "ball", then extend hand away from mouth and say "ball" again, third time, extend hand out to me, say "ball", and give ball to me whether I say ball or not.
