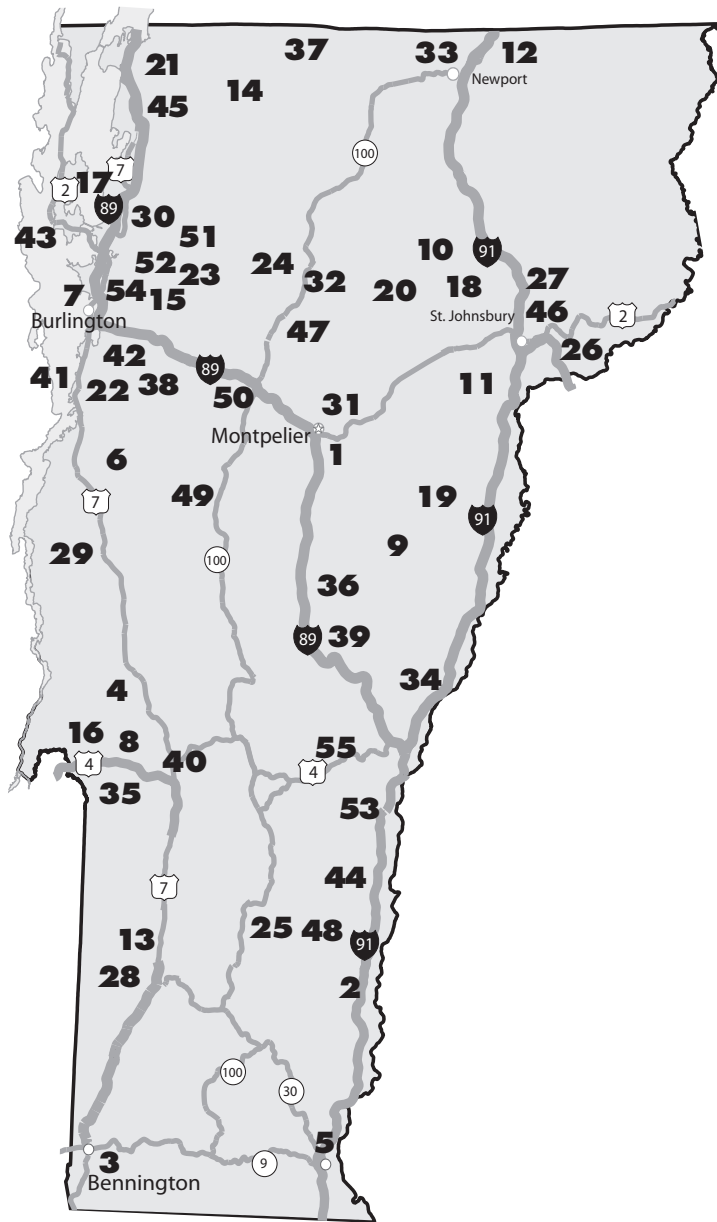


Farmers Markets Authorized To Accept Vermont Farm To Family Program Coupons in 2011

* This market also accepts 3SquaresVT food benefits. Look for the EBT/debit card table (see box).

1. ***BARRE:** Granite Center Farmers Market. Main Street (Route 302) on the green by City Hall. Wednesdays, 3 – 6:30 pm (May 18 – Oct 12)
2. ***BELLOWS FALLS** Farmers Market. Waypoint Center on Depot Street, by train station over bridge from Canal Street. Fridays, 4 – 7 pm (May 20 – Oct 21) Closes at 6:30 starting Sept 30.
3. ***BENNINGTON:** Walloomsac Farmers Market. In park behind Bennington Station restaurant on Depot Street, one block west of Route 7, just north of Route 7 & 9 junction. Tuesdays, 3:30 – 5:30 pm, and Saturdays, 10 am – 1 pm (May 7 – Oct 29)
4. **BRANDON** Farmers Market. Central Park, Route 7, middle of town. Fridays, 9 am – 2 pm (May 27 – Oct 7) and 10 am – 4 pm on Saturday, Oct 8.
5. ***BRATTLEBORO** Area Farmers Market. Saturdays, 9 am – 2 pm (May 7 - Oct 29) off Route 9 in West Brattleboro; and Wednesdays, 10 am - 2 pm (June 8 – Oct 26) in Gibson-Aiken Center across from post office on Main Street (Route 5).
5. ***BRATTLEBORO** at Samuel Elliot Apartments, 107 Elliot Street next to fire station. Elliot is off Main Street (Route 5) just south of Route 9 junction. Tuesdays, 4 – 6 pm (June 21 – Sept 27).
6. ***BRISTOL** Farmers Market. Town green on Route 17. Saturdays, 11 am – 2 pm (June 4 – Oct 1)
7. ***BURLINGTON** Farmers Market. In City Hall Park downtown. Saturdays, 8:30 am – 2 pm (May 7 – Oct 29)
7. ***BURLINGTON:** New North End Farmers Market. At Elks Lodge, 925 North Avenue, north of junction with Route 127. Thursdays, 3 – 6:30 pm (June 2 – Sept 29)
7. ***BURLINGTON:** Old North End Farmers Market. 6 Archibald Street, on green by HO Wheeler School. Tuesdays, 3 – 6:30 pm (June 7 – Oct 25)
8. **CASTLETON** Farmers Market. Off Route 4A downtown, in lot next to Citizens Bank. Thursdays, 3:30 – 6 pm (June 16 – Oct 6)
9. **CHELSEA** Farmers Market. North Common in village, junction of Routes 113 and 110. Wednesdays, 3 – 6:30 pm (May 20 – Oct 7)
10. **CRAFTSBURY COMMON** Farmers Market, on green by Craftsbury Common post office. Follow signs to Sterling College. Saturdays, 10 am – 1 pm (May 21 – Oct 8)
11. **DANVILLE:** Caledonia Farmers Market. Route 2, across from Larabee's Building Supply 1.3 miles west of town green. Wednesdays, 9 am – 1 pm (June 8 – Oct 5)
12. **DERBY** Farmers Market. Route 5, half-mile east of I-91 Exit 28, in field between Vianor tire and Elks Lodge. 9:30 am – 2:30 pm on Tuesdays (June 14 – Sept 13) and Saturdays (May 28 – Oct 8)
13. **DORSET** Farmers Market. At H. N. Williams store, Route 30 just south of village. Sundays, 10 am – 2 pm (May 15 – Oct 9)
14. **ENOSBURG FALLS** Farmers Market. Lincoln Park, Route 105, center of town. Wednesdays, 3 – 6 pm, and Saturdays, 9 am – 1 pm (May 25 – Oct 29) except 9 – 3 for Sept 17 Harvest Fest.
15. ***ESSEX JUNCTION:** Five Corners Farmers Market. Lincoln Place downtown, off Railroad Ave near five-way intersection. Fridays, 3:30 – 7:30 pm (June 3 – Oct 7) except closes at 6:30 starting Sept 9.
16. ***FAIR HAVEN** Farmers Market. Route 22A, south end of park near cannon. Fridays, 3 – 6 pm (June 10 – Oct 14) and 10 am – 5 pm on Sunday, July 24.
17. ***GRAND ISLE:** Champlain Islands Farmers Market. Route 2 at St. Joseph's Church, near A&B Beverage. Saturdays, 10 am – 2 pm (May 28 – Sept 24)
18. ***GREENSBORO** Farmers Market. Town Hall Green on East Craftsbury Road, ¼ mile from Willey's General Store in Greensboro village. Thursdays, 3 – 6 pm (June 9 – Sept 8)
19. **GROTON** Growers Market. Route 302 in village, in park across from church. Saturdays, 10 am – 1 pm (May 28 – Sept 24)
20. ***HARDWICK** Farmers Market. From Route 14-15 just west of village, turn onto Granite Street at Rite Way Sports. Market is 1/10 mile down Granite Street. Fridays, 3 – 6 pm (May 6 – Sept 30)
21. **HIGHGATE** Farmers Market. Route 78, 4 miles north of I-89 exit 21, in Highgate Center park by municipal building. Sundays, 9 am – 1 pm (June 26 – Oct 2)
22. **HINESBURG** Lions Farmers Market. United Church, Route 116 in center of town. Thursdays, 3:30 – 6:30 pm (June 2 – Sept 29)
23. **JERICHO:** Mills Riverside Farmers Market. Mills Riverside Park, east of village on Route 15 toward Underhill. Thursdays, 3 – 7 pm (June 2 – Sept 29)



24. **JOHNSON** Farmers Market. Route 15 downtown at United Church across from Grand Union. Tuesdays, 3 – 6 pm (May 24 – Oct 4)
25. **LONDONDERRY:** West River Farmers Market. At blinking light on Route 100 near Route 11 junction. Saturdays, 9 am – 1 pm (May 28 – Oct 8)
26. ***LUNENBURG** Farmers Market. Route 2 on town common. Wednesdays, 2 – 6 pm (June 1 – Oct 12)
27. ***LYNDONVILLE:** Lyndon Farmers Market. Bandstand park, Route 5 across from White's Market. Fridays, 3 – 7 pm (May 13 – Oct 14)
28. ***MANCHESTER CENTER:** Adams Park, Route 7A downtown, across from Gringo Jack's restaurant. Thursdays, 3 – 6 pm (June 2 – Oct 6)
29. ***MIDDLEBURY** Farmers Market. By the falls in Marbleworks shopping area downtown. 9 am – 12:30 pm on Wednesdays (June 15 – Oct 12) and Saturdays (May 7 – Oct 29)
30. **MILTON** Grange Farmers Market. Route 7, by high school just north of Hannafords. Saturdays, 9:30 am – 1:30 pm (June 11 – Oct 1)
31. ***MONTPELIER:** Capital City Farmers Market. 60 State Street, across from court house downtown. Saturdays, 9 am – 1 pm (May 7 – Oct 29)
32. **MORRISVILLE** Farmers Market. Fairground Plaza, Route 100, in front of Hannafords. Saturdays, 9 am – 1 pm (May 14 – Oct 15)
32. ***MORRISVILLE:** Lamoille Valley Year Round Farmers Artisan Market. River Arts Center by municipal lot, left onto Pleasant Street just north of blinking light. Wednesdays, 3 – 6:30 pm (May 11 – Sept 28) and inside on Saturday, Oct 8 (10 am – 2 pm)
33. ***NEWPORT** Farmers Market. Across from Wendy's on causeway between I-91 access road and Chamber of Commerce. Open 9 am – 2 pm on Wednesdays (June 15 – Oct 12) and Saturdays (May 14 – Oct 15)
34. ***NORWICH** Farmers Market. Route 5, one mile south of I-91 exit 13, next to Fogg's Hardware. Saturdays, 9 am – 1 pm (May 7 – Oct 29)
35. ***POULTNEY:** Vermont Farmers Market. Main Street, downtown. Thursdays, 9 am – 2 pm (June 23 – Oct 6)
36. **RANDOLPH** Farmers Market. Central Street next to Orange Southwest Supervisory Union office, Route 66. Saturdays, 9 am – 1 pm (May 21 – Oct 15)
37. **RICHFORD** Farmers Market. Peoples Trust lot, 21 Main Street across from Mac's Market before bridge. Saturdays, 9 am – 1 pm (June 18 – Oct 1)
38. ***RICHMOND** Farmers Market. At Route 2 stoplight, turn toward Huntington. Market is on right just before bridge. Fridays, 3 – 6:30 (June 3 – Oct 14)

39. ***ROYALTON** Farmers Market. On South Royalton green, off Route 14. Thursdays, 3 – 6:30 (May 26 – Oct 6)
40. ***RUTLAND:** Downtown Market in Depot Park by Walmart combines Rutland County Farmers Market and Vermont Farmers Market. 9 am – 2 pm on Saturdays (May 7 – Oct 29) and 3 – 6 pm on Tuesdays (May 17 – Oct 25)
41. **SHELBURNE** Farmers Market. Parade ground at Route 7 and Church Street junction. Saturdays, 9 am – 1 pm (May 28 – Oct 8)
42. ***SOUTH BURLINGTON** Farmers Market at Healthy Living. 222 Dorset Street (off Williston Rd) in field near Healthy Living Market. Every other Sunday, 10 am – 2 pm (June 19 – Oct 23)
43. ***SOUTH HERO:** Champlain Islands Farmers Market. St. Rose Church, Route 2. Wednesdays, 4 – 7 pm (June 1 – Sept 21) and for Saturday, Oct 8 Harvest Festival. Also Saturday, Oct 22 (10 am – 2 pm) at Congregational Church on South Street off Route 2.
44. ***SPRINGFIELD** Community Market. People's United Bank parking lot at traffic light downtown. Saturdays, 10 am – 1 pm (May 28 – Oct 8)
45. ***ST. ALBANS:** Northwest Farmers Market. Taylor Park, Main Street downtown. Saturdays, 9 am – 2 pm (May 21 – Oct 29)
46. ***ST. JOHNSBURY:** Caledonia Farmers Market. Pearl Street, behind theater and Sir Anthony's Diner. Saturdays, 9 am – 1 pm (May 14 – Oct 29)
47. **STOWE** Farmers Market. By Red Barn Shops, on Mountain Road (Route 108) two miles from Route 100. Sundays, 10:30 am – 3 pm (May 15 – Oct 16)
48. ***TOWNSHEND** Farmers Market. On the common at Routes 30 & 35 junction. Thursdays, 3:30 – 6:30 pm (June 2 – Oct 13)
49. **WAITSFIELD** Farmers Market. On the green, Route 100 in the village. Saturdays, 9 am – 1 pm (May 21 – Oct 22)
50. ***WATERBURY** Farmers Market. Rusty Parker Park, Route 2, by shopping center and train station. Thursdays, 3 – 7 pm (May 19 – Oct 6)
51. **WESTFORD** Farmers Market. Route 128, on the village common. Fridays, 3:30 – 6:30 pm (June 10 – Oct 14)
52. ***WILLISTON** Farmers Market. Village green, Route 2, next to library. Saturdays, 10 am – 2 pm (June 4 – Oct 15)
53. ***WINDSOR** Farmers Market. In the green off Route 5, center of town, near Mascoma Bank. Sundays, 1 – 4 pm (May 22 – Oct 30)
54. ***WINOOSKI** Farmers Market. Green next to Champlain Mill, near Routes 2-7-15 rotary intersection. Sundays, 10 am – 2 pm (June 12 – Oct 9)
55. **WOODSTOCK:** Mount Tom Farmers Market. Route 12, one mile north of village. Saturdays, 9:30 am – 12:30 pm (May 21 – Oct 15)
55. ***WOODSTOCK** Market on the Green. Center of town, junction of Routes 4 and 106. Wednesdays, 3 – 6 pm (June 8 – Oct 5)

EBT & Debit Cards at Markets

Vermont WIC Fruit & Veggie cards cannot be used at farmers markets. However, markets with a star accept Vermont Express EBT (electronic benefit transfer) and other debit cards. At the EBT/debit card table, tell the worker what kind of card you have and how many dollars you want to spend there, then swipe the card and enter your PIN number. You will get tokens to use as "money" at the market. The \$1 tokens may buy foods eligible for the 3SquaresVT program and sold by any vendor at the market. This includes any nonalcoholic beverage or food intended for human consumption, except prepared foods served hot, like spring rolls or pizza slices. It also includes seeds or starter plants to grow your own food. The \$5 tokens are for EBT or debit card cash accounts, and may buy any product sold at the market. Some EBT markets also give bonus "Harvest Health" coupons to EBT card shoppers.

Unlike Farm To Family coupons, these tokens and Harvest Health coupons may only be spent at the market where you got them.
