Form A: Petition for Requisition to Return a Runaway Juvenile

Form A - Petition for Requisition to Return a Runaway Juvenile is an optional form. It may be used for guidance as to substance, and a regular court petition may be substituted. The petition shall state the juvenile's name, date of birth, the status of the juvenile's custody, the circumstances of his/her running away, the location of the juvenile, if known at the time application is made, and such other facts as may tend to show that the juvenile who has run away is endangering his/her own welfare or the welfare of others.

The petition shall be verified by affidavit, shall be executed in duplicate and shall be accompanied by two certified copies of the document (s) on which the petitioner's entitlement to the juvenile's custody is based, such as birth certificate, letters of guardianship or custody decrees.
