

REMINDERS

It's Important That You:

1. Bring a voucher and \$27 copay for each animal to the vet's office, on or before the day of the surgery.
2. Keep your appointment. Call right away if you need to reschedule.
3. Be on time for drop off and pick up.
4. Make sure your animal is flea free before the surgery.
5. Talk to your vet about *included*¹ and *optional*² procedures before the surgery. Accept or decline any recommended *optional* procedures.
6. Pay for any *optional* procedures you accept.
7. Thank your vet for participating in this program!

-
1. **INCLUDED:** the cost of the entire surgical procedure, including the exam (even if it's required by the office prior to the day of surgery), maintenance, anesthesia, pain medication during surgery, discharge of your animal, removal of sutures, one series of the distemper vaccination and one rabies vaccination.
 2. **OPTIONAL (not included):** pain medication you take home for pain relief after the surgery, fees associated with surgical complications if your animal is in heat or pregnant and other procedures. Bring this check list with you and review the options below. If a veterinary office requires you to have any of these procedures, you may decline and call another office.
