NOTE : (Continued)

Benefits for categorically eligible households will be calculated using the Food Stamp rules. Households of one or two members who are categorically eligible are entitled to at least a \$16 benefit. Categorically eligible households of three or more must have their benefit amounts determined by the benefit tables at P-2590 D2-23. If they are not eligible for a benefit, they must be suspended, not denied. This means the household must

- continue to report changes
- continue to meet work registration requirements
- be recertified at regular intervals.
