

P-2214 DEDUCTIONS (continued)

P-2214C Dependent Care Expenses (Reach Up rule 2275)

Allow dependent care expenses for household members who are incapacitated adults not on the grant and for children not living in the home (and for whom the case manager cannot authorize childcare—this is rare).

Mileage reimbursement

Use the State of Vermont's current mileage reimbursement rate for travel to and from allowable dependent care.

BPS Support

Use the ESD Calculator found on the [ESD Intranet](#) to calculate dependent care mileage.

Enter allowable dependent care expenses on top section of DCEX panel (similar to child support/alimony paid out of the home if court ordered).

DCEX - F10 Change who is paying the daycare or child support cost

If entered in the bottom section, it will not pull into the Reach Up budget.

Reach Up uses this top section for allowable DCEF
