

## Purpose

To outline procedures Woodside has in place to assure compliance with state law concerning smoking in public buildings.

## Policy

Vermont Law requires that there will be no smoking of tobacco products within the facilities at any time.

Woodside Juvenile Rehabilitation Center will provide a smoke-free environment for residents, employees, and visitors.

This procedure covers the smoking of any tobacco product and the use of smokeless or "spit" tobacco and applies to both employees and non-employees.

Tobacco of all types, lighters, and matches are prohibited inside the secure portion of the building. These products may be stored in the lockers in the front entrance sally port or in personally owned vehicles.

Tobacco products will not be used within 50' of the building(s), i.e. main building, gym or any area that can be observed by residents.

A container will be maintained beyond the 50' limit for all discarded smoking materials. All staff are expected to utilize these containers for discarded smoking materials.
