## Policy

Family Services Policy 66 on Interviewing Children in Custody governs the actions of Woodside staff on this topic.

All requests from law enforcement to interview a resident will be referred to the Woodside Director, who will refer the matter to the resident's Family Services Worker.

If the interview is approved, the Director (or designee) will coordinate the meeting with the appropriate parties.
