

Purpose

To outline the minimum requirements for lights to be on at Woodside.

Policy

Woodside is open 24 hours a day and must be lighted adequately at all times in order to maintain a safe and secure environment.

- Lights over the front door, front desk, and sally port will be on at all times.
- Lights on units will remain fully illuminated during all waking hours. After lights out the outer ring of unit lights may be turned off leaving the inner ring of lights on. The Operations Supervisor on duty will ensure that the inner circle of lights in all units are on at all times. Any exceptions must be approved by the Operations Supervisor on duty.
- The hallway lights between units will remain on at all times.
- Parking lot lights will be on from dusk until dawn.
